

Tourist Visa | Uganda

Visa Requirements

- :: **Passport valid for six months on exit**
- :: **One blank visa page in passport**
- :: **Copy of passport information page**
- :: **One recent passport photograph**
- :: **Completed eVisa order form**

Please click the 'place order' button on the visa requirements page (<https://visabase.co.uk/uganda-visas-uk-nationals/tourist-visa/>) and complete the form, so we can submit an eVisa application on your behalf.

Once it's been processed, the embassy will grant you authorisation to travel.

When you arrive in Uganda, this must be presented to an Immigration Officer for final approval, before payment is submitted at the point of entry.

- :: **Yellow fever vaccination certificate**
- :: **Covering letter (multiple-entry applicants only)**

Please submit a covering letter explaining why you require a multiple-entry visa.

- :: **Letters of recommendation (multiple-entry applicants only)**

Multiple-entry visa applicants must provide recommendation letters from two referees in Uganda.

- :: **Police clearance certificate (multiple-entry applicants only)**

This must be provided either by Interpol or local police in the UK.

PLEASE NOTE

You may be able to obtain a visa on arrival in Uganda. However, the fees and requirements are the same and there is no guarantee of entry. We therefore strongly advise applicants to obtain a visa before travelling.

You may alternatively wish to apply for an East Africa Tourist visa. This is a multiple-entry visa, valid for 90 days, which allows the holder to travel between Uganda, Kenya and Rwanda for a flat fee of £70. Please contact us if you require further information.

Additional Information

- :: All necessary documents can either be provided as hard copies for us to scan and upload, or you can submit digital files via email. Supported file formats and size restrictions are listed at the bottom of the eVisa questionnaire.
- :: Visa fees are fixed in US dollars. The exact sum payable may therefore fluctuate according to the exchange rate.
- :: Please apply for your visa at least five working days before you plan to travel.
- :: The embassy reserves the right to request additional documents in support of your visa application, and to alter or increase fees without prior notice.
- :: No refund will be given if your visa is cancelled or rejected by the embassy.
